The land is 164 acres with 88% of it consisting of uplands. It has 131 acres of four year old planted pines that will provide future income. For the development minded individual, it is located 1.25 miles from I-75 and boasts a half mile of paved road frontage on GA Hwy 122. While currently zoned Ag-5 it is adjacent to a parcel zoned R-1 on the North East corner and lies less than a half mile from a planned development which is nearly at capacity. The potential for rezoning to residential is possible.






